#### **Aid for Ukraine**

*Gordon Siebring's son Gordie has been living in the Ukraine for 29 years. He lives NW of Kyiv near Belarus. Gordie has been providing aid to the people in his area including food, fuel and sleeping quarters. He has also been buying hogs and cattle from the people that are fleeing so they have the funds they need to leave the country. He is then using that livestock to feed the people including Ukrainian Military. If you would like to donate food or clothing, those items can be dropped off at Security Savings Bank in George. There is a trailer located in the Frontier Bank parking lot for the donation of clothes only. All food items should be brought to Security Savings Bank. All donated items will be shipped to Gordie for distribution in his area. Gordon is also setting up a fund at Security Savings Bank to cover the cost of buying food and shipping donated items. The cost of shipping will be approximately \$8000 for one container. If you wish to help out, please make your check payable to "Aid for the Ukraine" and drop off at any Security Savings Bank location. A list of items to donate is located in the narthex on the bulletin board. The cutoff for donation of **clothes and food ONLY** will be April 12<sup>th</sup>. There is no cutoff for monetary donations as of yet.*
